This post is challenging, extremely interesting and rewarding. This will involve providing supervision, support and care to a child in Year 1 with special educational needs including learning difficulties and some personal care needs. The postholder will work with this child and small groups of children with him included inside or outside the classroom to enable them to overcome a range of barriers to learning. Relevant training may be provided both within the school and by outside agencies to ensure all aspects of the child's needs are met.

The ideal candidate will have:

- previous TA experience and a good standard of literacy and numeracy
- Relevant Level 3 qualification (preferred, but not essential)
- a commitment to supporting and understanding pupil needs
